Sauvignon-Semillon, San Elian, 2013/14

Central Valley, Chile

On the nose, tropical fruit aromas whilst on the palate, citrus fruits, a light body and a balanced acidity. (2) 12.5% vol

Veneto, Italy

Light and leafy with a hint of pear and blossom. An easygoing match for almost anything. (2) 12% vol

Chardonnay, Santa Helena, 2013/14

Central Valley, Chile

Languedoc, South of France

Alsace, France

Marlborough, New Zealand

Central Valley, Chile

On the nose, aromas of black cherries, whilst on the palate, juicy red and black fruits combine with a medium body and soft tannins. (B) 13% vol

Mendoza, Argentina

Beaujolais, Burgundy, France

Vibrant aroma that is absolutely classic raspberries and cream. Soft texture and concentrated berry fruit give weight. (C) 13% vol

Rhône, France

The Perrin family are the very model of modern wine production. Their wines are deceptively simple and natural-tasting. Simply a perfect ripe juicy red - delicious to the last drop. (C) 13.5% vol

Shiraz, Crystal Brook, 2010/11

South East Australia

Immediately pleasing, spicy, fruity and neatly polished with plenty of sweet blackberry and prune fruit backed with a velvet overcoat. (C) 14.5% vol

Graciano Rioja Reserva, Azabache, 2006/07

Rioja, Spain

Deep dark red, with a fine fruit aroma. Vitality and confident fruit fill the palate, while nicely-balanced oak carries lush flavours right to the finish. (D) 14% vol

Barolo Flori, Araldica, 2009/10

Piemonte, Italy

The Nebbiolo's classic hints of tar and roses seem to be tucked in here. The roses are the top notes on the dark fruits, spice and dried orange peel; the tar gives it the trademark final bite. (D) 14% vol

Pinot Noir, Tom's Block, Neudorf, 2010/11

Nelson, New Zealand

A serious contender to Burgundy here from the Nelson pioneers. Gamey and spicy with pure raspberry and black cherry fruit all put together with a vanilla wood veneer that gives a glacier smoothness. (C) 14% vol
